Assessment checklist

Describe direction of feed on the router table and direction of rotation of the router bit	Assessor Initial
Describe ‘climb routing’ and the associated risks	
Explain the relationship between the bit size, the router speed and the depth of cut	
Describe practical ways to keep fingers clear of the bit (push sticks, feather boards, jigs)	
Demonstrate correct insertion of the bit, collet tension and height adjustment	
Demonstrate use of a round over bit along a length of timber	
Explain or demonstrate how you would use the round over bit on the end of the of the timber (i.e. support timber or jig required)	
Demonstrate routing a groove in a piece of timber	
Explain or demonstrate how to widen the groove (i.e. fence MUST be moved outwards and not inwards. Why?)	
Explain or demonstrate a change of bearing on a bearing-guided bit and demonstrate safe use of the bearing-guided bit	
Explain or demonstrate how the adjustable outfeed fence can be used to joint the edge of a timber
